

OVSC Predator Roundup 2012 Rules

These rules are established to make the hunt an enjoyable, challenging experience for all participants. All participants are expected to hunt in a sportsman's like manner observing all federal, state, and local laws. Failure to abide by these rules will result in disqualification of the entire team and forfeiture of registration fees.

OVSC Predator Roundup, the organizers, sponsors, and the Ontonagon Valley Sportsmen's Club are not liable for accidents or damages to participants. All participants must sign a Liability Waiver to participate, those refusing to do so will not be allowed to compete and will forfeit registration fees.

Teams may consist of 1 to 4 people.

1. Contest will begin Thursday, February 23, 2012 at 7:30 pm (est) and will end Sunday, February 26, 2012 at 4:00 pm (est). No Early Starts. All hunters must check in at Hoppy's Bar or Krupp's Mini Mart on Thursday evening or have a team representative check in and pick up their blocks. The hunt will end for all hunters at Hoppy's Bar, Kenton.

2. All participants must have current State of Michigan appropriate hunting license(s) and abide by all Michigan game laws. Fox and Bobcat require a Michigan Fur Harvesters license.

3. Use of dogs, calling, stalking, and baiting are the only acceptable methods of the hunt. Any predator with trap or snare marks or appears to have been killed prior to the start of the contest will be disqualified.

4. Predators must be harvested in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.

5. No road kills will be accepted.

6. Any participant or team deliberately attempting to deceive or cheat in the contest will be disqualified and banned from all future hunts.

7. Minors over the legal hunting age must register with an adult team member. Minors are not allowed to hunt alone or with another minor. Minors must have a Liability Waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian to participate.

8. All predators must be registered at Hoppy's Bar on Sunday between the hours of 1:00 pm and 4:00 pm {EST} in order to qualify for the contest.

9. Appointed judges will have final determination of any discrepancies and disqualifications. Judges rulings are final and registration fees will not be refunded to disqualified hunters.

10. Winners are determined by a point system:

BOBCAT 30 POINTS
COYOTE 25 POINTS
FOX 20 POINTS

In the event of a tie, total weight of all predators will determine the winner. If total weight does not break the tie, then the first team to check in will win the tie.
